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The Two Laws

1. “And he [God] gave unto Moses...two...tables of **stone**, written with **the finger of God**. Exodus 31:18
2. **Moses** wrote the [other] law in a **book** by his **handwriting**. “And **Moses** wrote this law...” Deuteronomy 31:9. “And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law **in a book...**” Deuteronomy 31:24.
3. Two DIFFERENT laws – One written on **STONE**, the other written in a **BOOK**. There were 2 writers (scribes) – **God** and **Moses**.
4. The other law (ceremonial) was put in **THE SIDE** of the ARK. Deuteronomy 31:26
5. The **ceremonial** law was a WITNESS AGAINST the individual (in the Old Testament). Deuteronomy 31:26
6. Colossians 2;14 (“Blotting out the **handwriting** of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross”) refers to the **ceremonial** law that **Moses** wrote in a **book**.
7. **Ordinances** pertain to **sacrifices**.
8. The bread and wine served in the Communion Service commemorate the **sacrifice** of **Jesus Christ**.
9. Ordinance identifies that **part** of the **handwritten law** that was **done away with**.
10. “...the **handwriting of ordinances...** was **against us**” Colossians 2:14
11. “The **handwriting of ordinances**” was (1) **taken out of the way** and (2) **nailed to His cross**. Colossians 2:14
12. The part of the handwritten law of Moses that was done away with at the cross is the animal sacrifices.
13. In Colossians 2:16 the word “days” is supplied in the phrase “in respect of the sabbath *days*”.
14. The drink offering was from **unfermented** grapes.
15. The **meat offering** was a **flour** made from **manna**. The word “meat” is an Old English word meaning food in general, not necessarily flesh food.
16. The wine and meat offering went on **the Altar of Sacrifice**.
17. The wine and meat offering that went on the Altar of Sacrifice represents **the Emblems of Communion**.
18. In Colossians 2: 16, the 5 things that are said in verse 17 that “are a **shadow of things to come**” are 1- **meat (food)**, 2- **drink**, 3- **respect of an holy day**, 4- the **new moon**, 5- **the Sabbath**.
19. Every animal sacrificed was a shadow of **Christ death**.
20. The animal sacrifices eventually turned into **the body of Christ**. Colossians 2:17

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
